Bad Girls of the Bible – February 24th – March 31st, 7pm

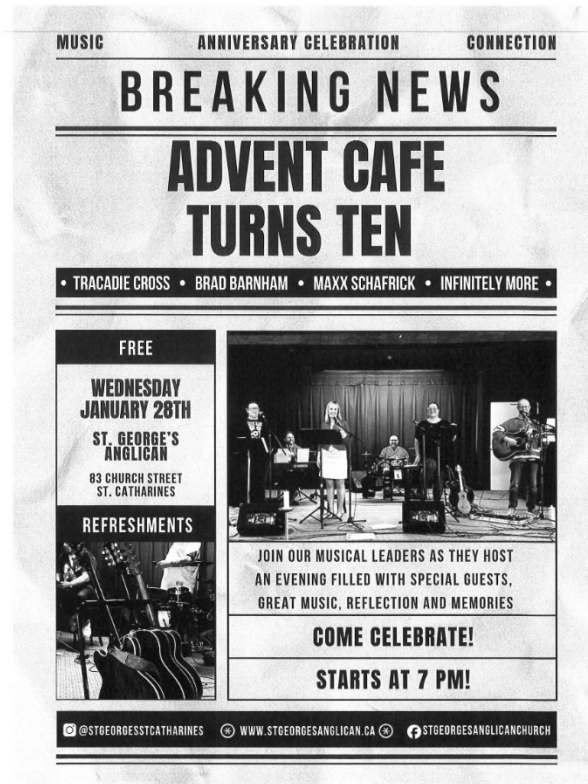
Prophets, teachers, evangelists, disciples, apostles, and leaders. Join us in a deep dive into the courageous and wise leadership of women in our life of faith.
